## 7<sup>th</sup> TIRANA CONNECTIVITY FORUM Building Better Balkans Together



### **Background Note**

Tirana Connectivity Forum 2021 will debate the challenges, discuss the conditions to be met, scan the actors and analyze the resources needed to increase the region's connectedness with the EU as a precondition to development and resilient growth.

TCF2021 will focus specifically on the Economic and Investment Plan (EIP) and its 10 Flagship Projects, shed light on factors that support or inhibit their efficient implementation, and follow up on the 2021 Berlin Process Civil Society and Think Tank Forum recommendations about the role of specialized CSOs and Think Tanks in their good governance.

Innovative forms of cooperation will be presented and debated, while new stakeholders such as youth organizations will outlay their view on the EIP, and on their take regarding resulting policies and projects.

To underline the role of Fundamentals in the overall Enlargement and in the convergence with EU, the TCF21 will kick off with a side event organized in partnership with the Dutch Embassy in Tirana in the framework of the initiative "Monitoring and Supporting Albania's reforms on its path to EU", implemented by Cooperation and Development Institute.

TCF2021 is part of the official calendar of the Slovenian Presidency of the EU and organized in partnership with Konrad Adenauer Stiftung, Friedrich Ebert Stiftung and Hanns Seidel Stiftung.
